Rules and Regulations

- Danceforce uniform is to be worn to all classes to ensure everyone is dancing in practical, safe clothing appropriate to the class.
- Jewellery is not to be worn.
- Hair to be tied back and off the face for all classes. A bun is required for all Ballet classes.
- Parents are not permitted to sit and watch children's classes. There will be
 opportunities in which parents will be invited to watch classes to enable
 them to see progress.
- Class times should be closely observed. If a child is unable to attend, the principal should be informed of this absence.
- Fees are paid monthly on the 1* of each month via Direct Debit over 12 months for the amount of weeks Danceforce runs throughout that year. Direct debit totals will be set by Danceforce and parents will be informed of that amount. Fees are due regardless of class absence, holidays or school closure. Any classes cancelled by Danceforce will be made up at a later date.
- Please report any absences to Miss Mel by emailing dance_force@outlook.com
- Please ensure your child goes to the toilet BEFORE class
- Parents are advised to collect their child from inside the class venue, unless
 otherwise informed by the parent. If someone else is picking your child up
 from class, the teacher should be informed prior. This is so we ensure every
 child is kept safe.
- During the time children are on the premises, they should behave in an appropriate manner. This avoids any unnecessary accidents, and it is for the safety of the child.
- Please respect others within the school, particularly when entering or leaving a class. Remember that other pupils may still be dancing or commencing their next class.
